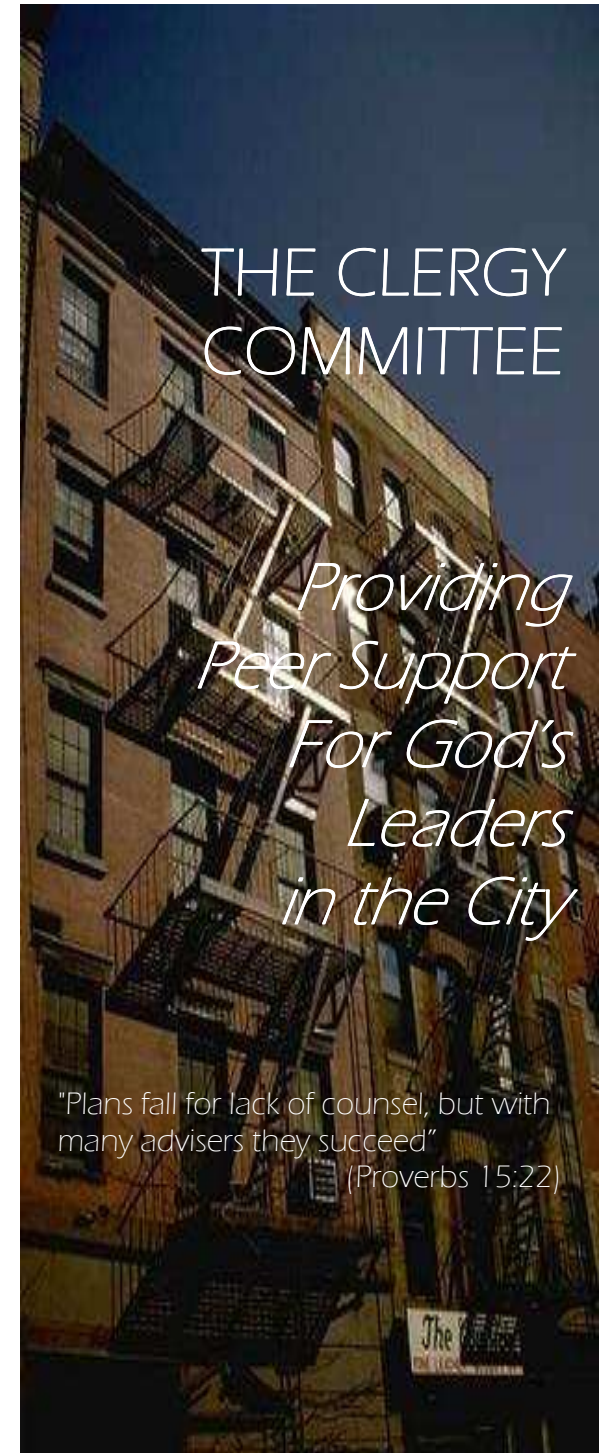

TCC is a select small group of twelve to fifteen urban ministers and directors of Christ-centered urban ministries. The goal of TCC is to create a safe, supportive, and trusting environment where ministry skills are sharpened, goals and visions are identified and implemented and ministers and ministries are made more effective.

THE CLERGY COMMITTEE is a national organization with groups in Austin, Denver, Los Angeles, Minneapolis and Philadelphia.

TCC consists of men and women in a multi-ethnic, multi-denominational and multi-generational setting.

THE CLERGY COMMITTEE'S monthly meetings provide expert skills development in areas of leadership, management, and ministry utilizing exceptional resource speakers, valued peer consultation and one-on-one accountability sessions with the committee chairman. TCC also provides encouragement and prayer support to its members.
